

# The DC Assistive Technology Program Receives a Sponsorship for FY 2026



Elevance Health is a major health company providing insurance and healthcare services. They offer Medicaid in DC. The company is sponsoring three DCATP outreach activities in FY 2026.

## The Get Connected Training

The Get Connected training program which teaches consumer's how to set up the accessibility features on their smartphones, tablets, and computers and how to use other features and apps on their device. DCATP will provide three training sessions at Elevance Health wellness centers for their members and help them learn to use the Elevance Health healthcare portal.



## Cane and Walker Clinic

Our Cane and Walker Clinic provide seniors and individuals with disabilities at low-income apartment buildings with free straight canes, quad canes, walkers, and replaces worn cane tips and walker glides. The items are purchased by sponsorship funds or donated to our reuse program.

## Medicaid Management

Our Medication Management Product Demonstration provides a guided demonstration of pill organizers for DC residents with disabilities and seniors. It includes easy to open, easy to fill, large capacity, portable (travel) pill organizers, smart pillboxes, and medication dispensers. The sponsorship funds enable DCATP staff to purchase the pillbox selected by the consumer after the demonstration or product loan from our lending library.
